About the Accounting Olympiad:

The Accounting Olympiad is a unique initiative of School of Commerce, Finance and Accountancy, CHRIST (Deemed to be University), Delhi NCR. The objective of the Olympiad is to identify the hidden talent in Accounting and inspire young minds to appreciate Accounting as a Subject. The Olympiad will provide a national platform of competition to young and talented students. The exam will promote excellence in accounting as an academic discipline and will help the students in solving conceptual and challenging problems in accounting. The competition will be held at national level.

Eligibility:

The students who are in standard 11th or 12th with commerce stream can participate in the Accounting Olympiad. The maximum age of the applicant shall not be more than 19 years.

Registration and Fee Payment:

The registration fee is Rs.150 per participant. Participants can pay the registration fee through scanning following bar code. Kindly select main head "Fest and Conference" and then sub head "Accounting Olympiad" to pay the fee.

Levels of Exam:

There will be two levels of this exam.

- Level I: It will be qualifying in nature.
- Level II: Students who will qualify the first level, will be eligible to appear for the second level exam.



Mode of Exam:

- Level I: The exam will be in online mode. Candidates will receive a Google form link comprising all the questions on their registered email ID. Candidates must finish the test within allocated time. Submissions will not be allowed after expiry of time.
- Level II: The exam will be in the offline mode. It will be conducted at CHRIST (Deemed to be University), Delhi NCR Campus.

Type of Questions, Marking scheme and Duration of exam:

- Level I: 30 Multiple Choice Questions will be asked. Each question will carry 1 mark. The duration of the exam will be 25 minutes.
- Level II: 60 Multiple Choice Questions will be asked in exam. Each question will carks. Negative marking shall be applicable for this exam (0.25 mark for each wrong answer).

Syllabus for Level I and II:

Accounting concepts and conventions, Introduction of Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS), Journalizing, Posting and Balancing, Subsidiary Books, Trial Balance, Rectification of errors, Bank Reconciliation Statement, Depreciation, Provisions and Reserves, Accounting for Bills of Exchange, Financial Statements of Sole Proprietorship Partnership and Companies, Accounting from incomplete records, Accounting for partnership firms, Accounting for Share Capital and debentures, Redemption of preference shares and debentures, Ratio Analysis, Cash Flow Statement, Accounting for Not For Profit Organizations, Accounting for consignments, Accounting for joint ventures.

Resource Materials:

Applicants can use NCERT Books for class 11th and 12th, Foundation level study material of ICAI (Institute of Chartered Accountants of India), ICSI (Institute of Company Secretaries of India) and ICMAI (Institute of Cost Accountants of India). All these resources are freely available and can be downloaded in PDF format from the website of respective institute.

Date and timing of exams:

- Level I: Sunday, 09 April, 2023 (Online), 10:00 AM to 10:25 AM
- Level II: Sunday, 16 April, 2023 (Offline), 11:00 AM to 01:00 PM. The reporting time shall be 10:30 AM.
