Join the Quest: Driving Positive Social Change

The Young Changemakers Programme acknowledges the dedication and hard work of its participants. Completing the three-day bootcamp successfully will earn them a **Programme Participant Certificate**, proving their training and commitment to driving positive social change.

The top performers will receive a **Programme Laureate Certificate** to recognize their innovative ideas for solving social problems in rural areas, commending their abilities, and their potential as future social changemakers. Distinguished performers will also receive mentoring on the implementation scope and viability of their solutions to effectively prepare them to become actionable social changemakers.

Eligibility

The programme is open to students of all academic backgrounds currently enrolled in 10th, 11th, 12th grade, or any equivalent programme. Students who have recently completed school can also apply.



Registration

The programme will be held from 26th to 28th May 2023, 9 AM to 6 PM. The fees is ₹3000 for the three-day experience, and all the proceeds will go to asisst the Rasabeda Community.

Note: To ensure a spot in the program, we encourage interested students to apply early and seize the opportunity.

Accommodation & Transport

This is a non-residential programme. Guardians are requested to drop and collect their wards from the IIM Ranchi Campus at 9 AM and 6 PM, respectively.

The Rasabeda visit will take place on day two via a private bus departing and returning to the IIM Ranchi Campus. The village is 45 km away and a 30 minutes trek after the bus ride.

The workshops and presentations will be held at IIM Ranchi, Lunch and refreshments will be provided on all days.
