WII-Category 2 Centre on World Natural Heritage Management for Asia and the Pacific Region is based in Dehradun is engaged in preparation of Nomination Dossier of Bhedaghat-Lametaghat in Narmada Valley (Jabalpur) Madhya Pradesh. In this connection, we are glad to announce a writing competition "composition or poetry" as part of the process of writing dossier. This competition is intended to create the awareness among the civil society towards world heritage in India.

Brief Description: Bhedaghat-Lametaghat is located near the Jabalpur district in Madhya Pradesh (India). It is the part of Narmada River which is flowing flawlessly and makes a famous Dhuandhar (Smoky) waterfall. A gorge and marble rocks enhance its beauty and make it suitable for the potential candidate for the inscription of World Heritage Site.

Entries are invited to **adorn the beauty and facts of Bhedaghat-Lametaghat, It's waterfall, gorge, marble rocks and River Narmada as lifeline with its cultural values.**

Guideline of Submission:

- (I) Write either composition or poetry to "**Adorn the beauty and facts of Bhedaghat-Lametaghat, It's waterfall, gorge, marble rocks and River Narmada as lifeline with its cultural values**".
- (II) **Language: English or Hindi** (Typed or Hand Written)
- (III) **Prizes :**
 - 1st Prize: Rs 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand Only)
 - 2nd Prize: Rs. 7500/- (Rs. Seven Thousand and Five Hundred Only)
 - 3rd Prize : Rs. 5000/- (Rs. 5000/- Thousand Only)
- (IV) **Word Limit:** Entry should be minimum 2000 words for composition and minimum 20 stanzas (4 lines in each stanza for poetry).
- (V) **Submission:** Entries will be submitted only through email to mailtoc2c@wii.gov.in by **15th June 2023 at 23:59 Hrs.**

(VI) **Rules and Regulations:**

- The writing competition is open to all the citizens of India.
- There is no entry fee for the competition.
- A participant can send only one entry. In case it is found that any participant has submitted more than one entry, all the entries will be considered as invalid for the said participant.
- The composition/poetry must be the original work of the entrant (written by participant) and must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity, moral rights, other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity. Participants are advised to not to use material copied from internet/other sources.
- The entry (composition/poetry) may not have been published elsewhere, in whole or in part, either prior to the contest or concurrently.
- **Authors must not use their name or personal details on the body of the text. Information may be submitted separately in the email text box. Please provide details such as name, complete postal address, email id and phone number in the email text box.**
- WII-C2C will have the right to publish or reproduce at any time all or part of the composition/poetry entered for the competition.
- Provide valid and active email id for further communication. Winners will only be communicated through mail and the prize will be paid through electronic mode (Net Banking) to the account specified by the winners.
- No requests relating to claims of re-evaluation of the entries will be considered.
- WII-C2C reserves the right to cancel or amend all or any part of the competition and/ or the Terms & Conditions/Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria.
- At any stage of evaluation, if an entry is found to violate the guidelines, the entry will be removed from evaluation process without giving any intimation.
- Any dispute or any issue related to this competition would be decided by WII-C2C, which will be final and binding.
