- V. The participant should submit a high-resolution (600 dpi) image of the logo (with slogan) in JPEG, PNG, BMP, TIFF formats only.
- VI. The Logo and Slogan should be usable on the website/mobile app/social media such as Twitter/Facebook/Instagram and on Magazines, Commercial Hoardings/Standees, Brochures, Leaflets, and Pamphlets, Souvenirs and other Publicity and Marketing materials.
