You grant the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade a royalty-free, non-exclusive, worldwide license to use, reproduce, modify, publish, distribute, and display your selfie in any and all media, including but not limited to government websites, social media pages, and print publications.
- 3. You agree that the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade may use your selfie for any purpose, including but not limited to promoting government programs and services, educating the public about government initiatives, and raising awareness of important social issues.
- 4. You represent and warrant that you are the sole owner of the copyright in your selfie and that you have the right to grant the license described above.
- 5. The selfie posted by you does not have any harmful message/ does not hurt the sentiments of any. The content posted by you should not be disrespectful of the Hon'ble Prime Minister or any government initiative.
- 6. The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade reserves the right to select or reject any selfie.
- 7. Participants must make sure that the information in their profile is accurate and updated as it will be used for any further communications. This includes name, address, email address, phone number, nationality, photo, etc. Any entry with incomplete or inaccurate information will not be considered.
- 8. The participant will take the undertaking that the work submitted is original and their own work.
- 9. The initial entry shall be submitted in JPEG and PDF format only.
- The file should be of high resolution at least 1000 pixels per inch at 100% size. The file should look clean (not pixilated or bit-mapped) when viewed onscreen at 100%. Entries should not be submitted in compressed or selfextracting formats.
- 11. The content must be original and should not violate any provision of the Indian Copyright Act, 1957. Anyone found infringing on others' copyright would be disqualified from the competition. The government of India does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participants.
