Terms and Conditions

1. The competition is open to all Indian citizens.
2. All entries must be submitted through the MyGov www.mygov.in portal only. Entries submitted through any other medium/mode will not be considered for evaluation.
3. The language of the composition should be Hindi, and they should be typed in Unicode font.
4. The length of the Essay must not exceed 2000 words.
5. Participants can submit only once. In case it is found that any participant has submitted more than one entry, all his/her entries will be considered invalid.
6. The entry should be original. Copied entries or plagiarized entries will not be considered under the contest. Winning entries will be published in an Annual Hindi Magazine "Arunima" by the National Commission for Women.
7. There are no charges/registration fees for participation in the competition.
8. The participants must be the same person who has written the essay. The Essay should reflect original thinking and presentation.
9. Please note that the Essay must be original and should not violate any provision of the Indian Copyright Act 1957. Anyone found infringing on others' copyright would be disqualified from the competition. National Commission for Women does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participants.
10. The National Commission for Women reserves the right to verify original documents such as proof of age etc., before awarding the prizes.
11. The participant should ensure that his / her MyGov profile is accurate and updated since the Ministry would use this for further communication.
12. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel or amend all or any part of the competition/guidelines/evaluation criteria etc., at any time.

13. Any changes to the Terms and Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria, or cancellation of the Contest, will be updated/posted on the MyGov platform. It would be the responsibility of the participants to keep themselves informed of any changes in the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria stated for this Contest.
14. If any entry is found to violate the guidelines, it will be removed from the evaluation process without giving any intimation or explanation to the participant.
15. For Verification purposes original documents may be asked by the National Commission for Women at any given point of time during the Competition process.
16. The National Commission for Women shall have an exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual, and irrevocable license to copy, store, edit, distribute, transmit, and publish competition entries.
17. The decision of the Evaluation Committee will be final and binding on all participants.
18. Non- conformity to guidelines will lead to disqualification of the participants.
19. All disputes/ legal complaints are subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi only. Expenses incurred for this purpose will be borne by the parties themselves.
20. Organizers' decision on the competition shall be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the same.
