Terms & Conditions

1. The competition is open for all Indian citizens
2. All the entries should be in PDF format
3. Entries must be original works by the creator.
4. The entries could be hand-drawn sketches, paintings with any medium, and illustrations.
5. It should be ensured that the uploaded poster is clearly visible along with the text and graphics/ image.
6. Participant needs to register themselves at MyGov for participating the contest.
7. Once submitted an entry cannot be withdrawn.
8. One participant can participate only once.
9. Please note that the Essay must be original and should not violate any provision of the Indian Copyright Act 1957. Anyone found infringing on others' copyright would be disqualified from the competition. National Commission for Women does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participants.
10. Organizers will not accept any responsibility for entries that are lost/late/ incomplete or have not been transmitted due to computer error or any other error beyond the organizer's reasonable control. Please note proof of submission of the entry is not proof of receipt of the same.
11. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, organizers reserve the right to amend or withdraw the contest at any time. For the avoidance of doubt, this includes the right to amend these terms and conditions
12. By entering the contest, a participant accepts and agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
13. Organizers reserve all rights to disqualify or refuse participation to any participant if they deem participation or association of any participant which is detrimental to the contest or the Organizers or partners of the competition. The

registrations shall be void if the information received by the Organizers is illegible, incomplete, damaged, false or erroneous.

14. Organizers' decision on the contest shall be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the same.
