2. All the entries should be in PDF/jpg format
3. This competition supports the CARA's Mission for raising awareness towards Foster Care and Foster Adoption.
4. The Slogans can be submitted in either English or Hindi
5. All entries must be submitted at www.mygov.in. Entries through other means will not be considered.
6. Participants grant the organizers an exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license to all rights, including intellectual property, for their submissions.
7. Organizers have the right to publish, use, adapt, edit, and modify submissions in any media, worldwide and in perpetuity, for purposes including advertising and promotion.
8. Participants agree not to claim ownership of submissions and will assist organizers in obtaining intellectual property registration if required.
9. Submissions must include a brief description and must be original, complying with the Indian Copyright Act, 1957. Infringements will result in disqualification.
10. Participants must own all rights and interests in their submissions.
11. Participants should ensure their MyGov profile is complete. This profile will be used by the Ministry of Women and Child Development for all future communications.
12. Organizers reserve the right to amend or withdraw the competition and terms at any time.
13. Submissions must not contain illegal, obscene, provocative, or inappropriate content.
14. The committee's decision is final. No re-evaluation requests will be entertained.
15. These terms are governed by Indian law.
