### **Terms and Conditions**

1. The contest is open to all Indian citizens.
2. Participants must ensure that their MyGov profile is complete and up-to-date for communication purposes.
3. The organizers reserve the right to disqualify or refuse participation from any individual if deemed necessary.
4. By entering the Contest, participants agree to comply with and be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
5. Employees and individuals directly or indirectly involved in the organization of the contest, as well as their immediate family members, are not eligible to participate.
6. Submissions containing offensive language, derogatory content, or violations of existing copyrights or trademarks will not be accepted. All entries must be original, and participants must ensure that their design is free from any infringement on third-party intellectual property rights, including but not limited to the Indian Copyright Act, 1957.
7. The organizers are not responsible for any lost, late, incomplete, or technically flawed entries. Submission proof does not guarantee receipt.
8. Participation deemed harmful or detrimental by the organizers may result in disqualification or restriction.
9. Proof of identity may be requested from the winners.
10. Participants must provide complete and accurate information for registration. Incomplete or illegible registrations will be considered void.
11. Participants must be at least 18 years of age to submit an entry.
12. There is no entry fee for participating in the contest.
13. Contestants are allowed to submit multiple entries.
14. Submissions will only be accepted through the MyGov portal.
15. Submissions must not contain illegal, offensive, objectionable, inappropriate content, or political overtones.
16. Participants found engaging in malpractices such as impersonation will be disqualified.
17. Entries received after the submission deadline will not be considered.
18. The organizers reserves the right to modify contest deadlines or dates due to circumstances beyond its control.
19. The organizers holds the right to use any submission, regardless of whether it wins, in any manner it deems appropriate.
20. The contest will be conducted in English and Hindi. Once submitted, entries cannot be withdrawn.
21. In case of any disputes, the decision of the organizers will be final.
