

Scriptwriting competition for promotion of Jan Aushadhi

Terms & Conditions

1. Entrants can make only **one submission**.
2. The competition is open only to all citizens of India.
3. The word limit for the script is 500 words max and it can be written in Hindi or English.
4. The script should be written in A4 un-ruled sheet.
5. The document should be handwritten and scanned in PDF format.
6. Usage of AI tools would strictly lead to cancellation of entries.
7. The competition will be live from **22nd February to 7th March**
8. The entry must be original and should not violate any provision of the Indian Copyright Act, 1957 and must not infringe on the intellectual rights of any third party.
9. The entry must not contain any provocative, objectionable, or inappropriate content.
10. The participating & winning entries would be the intellectual property of the PMBI, and the participants shall not exercise any right over it.
11. The entries may be used by the PMBI for Janaushadhi campaign for promotional and display purposes, IEC (Information, Education, and Communication) materials, and for any other use as may be deemed appropriate.
12. The name/title/caption of the script should be original and must not infringe on the Intellectual Property Rights of any third party.
13. The participant should enter the following information for further communication. Entries with incomplete profiles would not be considered.
14. All the entries received by MyGov would be assessed by a committee of judges. The decision of the Committee shall be final and binding.
15. Entries would be judged based on elements of creativity, originality, composition, simplicity, artistic merit and how well they communicate the elements that need to be reflected.
16. All entries would be required to give the copyright of the script to the PMBI.
17. PMBI has all rights to cancel activity at any time without assigning any reason.
